Pattern for Incubator Blanket - Section 4 Knitting, Class 1

Double knitting yarn, No. 8 needles, Basketweave effect

Cast on 100 stitches

Rows 1-10, knit

Rows 11-20, knit 10 *knit 10, purl 10*, repeat * to * until 10 stitches are left and then knit 10.

Rows 21-30, knit 10 *purl 10, knit 10*, repeat *to* until 10 stitches are left and then knit 10.

Continue with this pattern until the blanket measures approx 20/20in. and then knit 10 rows.
