1. The Exhibition is Open to All Comers.
2. All Articles exhibited must be the property of, and made by, the Exhibitor.
3. Each Article for Competition must have Exhibitor's Name, in sealed envelope, securely attached. Section and Class Number only to be written on the Envelope, unless otherwise stated.
4. An Entry Fee of 10p per Exhibit, to be paid at door of Marquee, with the exception of the Children (12 and Under) which is free.
5. No Exhibitor will be allowed more than ONE entry in each Class of Baking, Preserves, Dairying, Knitting, Sewing, Miscellaneous and Age 16 and Under Sections. In other Sections, no more than TWO per class allowed.
6. Knitted articles to be shown unwashed. Sewn articles may be washed.
7. Knitted and Sewn articles must have been worked entirely since 18th July, 2011.

# **PATTERN FOR BABY'S KNITTED BONNET, MITTS AND BOOTEES - SECTION 4, CLASS 4**

*To be donated to a Special Nursery*

## **BONNET**

Using 3 mm. Needles cast on 65 (73, 81,89) sts.

Commencing with a K. row, work in st.st. for 3 rows, finishing on a right side row.

**Eyelet Row** (Wrong side) - P.1, \*y.r.n., P.2tog., rept. from \* to end.

Commencing with a K. row, work in st.st. for 4 rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

Place markers at both ends of last row.

Change to 3¼ mm. needles.

### **Commence Pattern**

**1st Row** (Right side) - Knit.

**2nd and Every Following Alt. Row** - Purl.

**3rd Row** - K.3, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., \*K.5, y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., rept. from \* to last 3 sts., K.3.

**5th Row** - K.2, y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., M.B., K.2tog., y.fwd., \*K.3, y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., M.B., K.2tog., y.fwd., rept. from \* to last 2 sts., K.2.

**7th Row** - As 3rd Row.

**8th Row** - Purl.

Commencing with a K. row, continue in st.st. until Bonnet measures 8 (9, 10, 11) cm., 3 (3½, 4, 4¼) ins., from eyelet row, finishing on a wrong side row.

### **Shape Crown**

**1st Row** (Right side) - K.6 (7, 8, 9), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., \*K.11 (13, 15, 17), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., rept. from \* to last 6 (7, 8, 9) sts., K. to end. 57 (65, 73, 81) sts.

**2nd and Every Following Alt. Row** - Purl.

**3rd Row** - K.5 (6, 7, 8), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., \*K.9 (11, 13, 15), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., rept. from \* to last 5 (6, 7, 8) sts., K. to end. 49 (57, 65, 73) sts.

**5th Row** - K.4 (5, 6, 7), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., \*K.7 (9, 11, 13), K.2tog., K.1 sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., rept. from \* to last 4 (5, 6, 7) sts., K. to end. 41 (49, 57, 65) sts.

**7th Row** - K.3 (4, 5, 6), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., \*K.5 (7, 9, 11), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., rept. from \* to last 3 (4, 5, 6) sts., K. to end. 33 (41, 49, 57) sts.

**9th Row** - K.2 (3, 4, 5), K.2tog., K.1, Sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., \*K.3 (5, 7, 9), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., rept. from \* to last 2 (3, 4, 5) sts., K. to end. 25 (33, 41, 49) sts.

**11th Row** - K.1 (2, 3, 4), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., \*K.1 (3, 5, 7), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., rept. from \* to last 1 (2, 3, 4) sts., K. to end. 17 (25, 33, 41) sts.

### **2nd, 3rd and 4th Sizes Only**

**13th Row** - K. (1, 2, 3), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1 K.1, p.s.s.o., \*K. (1, 3, 5), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., rept. from \* to last (1, 2, 3) sts., K. to end, (17, 25, 33) sts.

### **3rd and 4th Sizes Only**

**15th Row** - K. (1, 2), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1 K.1, p.s.s.o., \*K. (1, 3), K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., rept. from \* to last (1, 2) sts., K. to end, (17, 25) sts.

### **4th Size Only**

**17th Row** - K.1, K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., \*K.1, K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., rept. from \* to last st., K.1. 17 sts.

### **All Sizes**

**Next Row** (Wrong side) - Purl.

**Next Row** - (K.2tog.) 8 times, K.1. Break yarn and thread through remaining 9 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off securely.

## **PRESSING**

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given.

Press as instructions given on ball band.

## **MAKING UP**

Join crown seam by top-sewing.

### **Neck Edging**

With right side facing and using 3 mm. Needles, pick up and K. 37 (39, 41, 43) sts. evenly along neck edge between markers. Commencing with a P. row, work in st.st. for 3 rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

**Eyelet Row** (Right side) - K.1, \*y.fwd., K.2tog., rept. from \* to end.

Commencing with a P. row, work in st.st for 3 rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

Cast off.

Join row-end edges of Edgings at corners. Fold Edging to inside along eyelet rows and stitch in place.

Knit on a small strap, a 5 stitch band in garter stitch about 2½ in. long and then fix with a button, no ribbon.

## **BOOTEES (Make 2)**

Using 3 mm. Needles cast on 25 (29, 33, 37) sts.

Commencing with a K. row, work in st.st for 3 rows, finishing on a right side row.

**Eyelet Row** (Wrong side) - P.1, \*y.r.n., P.2tog., rept. from \* to end.

Commencing with a K. row, work in st.st for 4 rows, finishing on a wrong side row. Change to 3¼ mm. Needles.

Commencing with a K. row, work in st.st. for 4 (6, 8, 10) rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

**Next Row** (Right side) - K.1 (3, 2, 1), \*y.fwd., K.2tog., K.1, rept. from \* to last 0 (2, 1, 0) sts., K.0 (2, 1, 0).

**Next Row** - Purl.

### **Shape Instep**

**Next Row** (Right side) - K.17 (21, 22, 24) and turn.

**Next Row** - P.9 (9, 11, 11) and turn.

Work in st.st. on these 9 (9, 11, 11) sts. only for a further 4 (4, 6, 6) rows.

### **Commence Pattern**

**1st Row** (Right side) - K.3 (3, 4, 4), y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K. to end.

**2nd Row** - Purl.

**3rd Row** - K.2 (2, 3, 3), y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., M.B., K.2tog., y.fwd., K. to end.

**4th Row** - Purl.

**5th Row** - As 1st Row.

Commencing with a P. row, work in st.st. for a further 3 (5, 5, 7) rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

Break yarn.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn and pick up and K. 10 (11, 12, 13) sts. along first side of Instep, K.9 (9, 11, 11) Instep sts., pick up and K. 10 (11, 12, 13) sts. along other side of Instep, K. to end. 45 (51, 57, 63) sts.

Work in st.st. for a further 6 (6, 8, 8) rows, placing markers at each end of 4th (4th, 6th, 6th) of these rows.

**Eyelet Row** (Wrong side) - P.1, \*y.r.n., P.2tog., rept. from \* to end.

Work in st.st for a further 4 rows, placing markers at each end of 3rd of these rows and finishing on a wrong side row.

### **Shape Sole**

**1st Row** (Right side) - K.1, K.2tog., K.3 (4, 5, 5) sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.6 (7, 8 11), [sl.1 K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.3 (4, 5, 5)] twice, sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.6 (7, 8 11), sl.1 K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.3 (4, 5, 5), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1. 33 (39, 45, 51) sts.

**2nd and Every Following Alt. Row** - Purl.

**3rd Row** - K.1, K.2tog., K.1 (2, 3, 3), sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.4 (5, 6, 9), [sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.1 (2, 3, 3)] twice, sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.4 (5, 6, 9), sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.1 (2, 3, 3), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1. 21 (27, 33, 39) sts.

### **3rd and 4th Sizes Only**

**5th Row** - K.1, K.2tog., K.1, sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.(4, 7), [sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.1] twice, sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K. (4, 7), sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, (21,27) sts.

### **All Sizes**

**Next Row** (wrong side) Purl.

Cast off.

## **PRESSING**

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given.

Press as instructions given on ball band.

## **MAKING UP**

Join back and foot seam by top-sewing. Fold Bootees along foot eyelet row and sew marked rows together on inside to form pleat.

Fold first 3 rows to inside along eyelet row and stitch in place.

Cut ribbon into 2 equal lengths and thread through holes at ankle, tying in bow at front.

## **MITTS**

### **RIGHT MITT**

Using 3 mm. Needles cast on 23 (27, 31, 35) sts. Commencing with a K. row, work in st.st. for 3 rows, finishing on a right side row.

**Eyelet Row** (Wrong side) - P1, \*y.r.n., P.2tog., rept. from \* to end.

Commencing with a K. row, work in st.st. for 4 rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

Change to 3¼ mm. Needles.

Commencing with a K. row, work in st.st for 4 (6, 8, 10) rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

**Next Row** (Right side) - K. 3 (2, 2, 3), \*y.fwd., K.2tog., K.1, rept. from \* to last 2 (1, 1, 2) sts., K.2 (1, 1, 2).

Work in st.st. for a further 5 (7, 9, 11) rows, finishing on a wrong side row.\*\*

#### **Commence Pattern**

**1st Row** (Right side) - K.5 (6, 7, 8), y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y. fwd., K. to end.

**2nd Row** - Purl.

**3rd Row** - K.4 (5, 6, 7), y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., M.B., K.2tog., y.fwd., K. to end.

**4th Row** - Purl.

**5th Row** - As 1st Row.

\*\*\*Commencing with a P. row, work in st.st. for a further 1 (3, 5, 7) rows, finishing on a wrong side row.

#### **Shape Top**

**1st Row** (Right side) - K.1, [Sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.6 (8, 10, 12), K.2tog., K.1] twice. 19 (23, 27, 31) sts.

**2nd and Every Following Alt. Row** - Purl.

**3rd Row** - K.1, [sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.4 (6, 8, 10), K.2tog., K.1] twice. 15 (19, 23, 27) sts.

**5th Row** - K.1 [sl.1 K.1, p.s.s.o., K.2 (4, 6, 8), K.2tog., K.1] twice. 11 (15, 19, 23) sts.

**6th Row** - Purl.

Cast off.

#### **LEFT MITT**

Work as given for Right Mitt to \*\*.

#### **Commence Pattern**

**1st Row** (Right side) - K.15 (18, 21, 24), y.fwd., sl.1, K.2tog., p.s.s.o., y.fwd., K. to end.

**2nd Row** - Purl.

**3rd Row** - K.14 (17, 20, 23), y.fwd., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., M.B., K.2tog., y.fwd., K. to end.

**4th Row** - Purl.

**5th Row** - As 1st Row.

Complete as given for Right Mitt from \*\*\*.

## **PRESSING**

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given.

Press as instructions given on ball band.

## **MAKING UP**

Join side and top seam by top-sewing. Fold first 3 rows to inside along eyelet row and stitch in place. Cut ribbon into 2 equal lengths and thread through holes at wrist, tying in bow at front.
