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RULES OF COMPETITION

1. The Competition is open to Members of Clubs in the Grampian North Area affiliated to the Scottish Association of Young Farmers' Clubs. No club may put forward more than three teams, including an "All Ladies" team.
2. Entries close on THURSDAY, 1st JULY, 2010 and must be made to the Secretary on the attached Entry Form.
3. Entry Money for each Team is £1, to be paid at time of entry.
4. Competitors are forbidden to communicate with each other or with any other person during the competition, under penalty of disqualification.
5. In the event of a tie, the teams may be called on to give reasons for the placing of one class of Stock.
6. The decision of the Judges and Committee shall be final.
7. All orders by the Committee must be obeyed.
8. Each Competitor shall judge the following classes and shall be allowed 7 minutes in each class (1) 4 Dairy Cows or Heifers, (2) 4 Fat Bullocks, (3) 4 Yearling Bullocks, (4) 4 Pens of Two Fat Lambs, (5) Ewes. The Competition shall commence at 12 until 2pm on Sunday, 18th July. Competitors will assemble at Y.F.C. Caravan.

5. Entry to be returned to the Secretary not later than 1st July, 2010.

Recipe for Cloudy Lemonade

1 Litre chilled fizzy water

4 x 15ml tablespoons castor sugar or to taste

2 whole unwaxed lemons, cut into eighths.

Ice cubes

Put the water, lemon and sugar into a blender in two batches, and blitz until the lemon is pureed.

Strain the lemonade into a jug, pressing down into the sieve, and then pour it into tumblers filled with ice.
